

#### ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Nestled around the Dawin Valley with the river Pushphhadra flowing nearby and in the divine grace of Rishi Markandaya Temple, a new abode of higher learning Govt. College Jukhala came into being on February 22, 2007. The sprawling campus is spreading in several acres in sylvan surroundings that bless it with an unmatched serenity. The lush green valley sends the signals of inspiration and adds to its natural beauty, which augments both academic and professional atmosphere of the institution. Affiliated to Himachal Pradesh University Shimla, the college is imparting education mainly to rural youth in various disciplines i.e. humanities, science and commerce at undergraduate level. The admission in bachelor's degree course in all disciplines is offered as per HPU norms. The college is recognized by University Grants Commission, New Delhi and is covered under section 12(B) and 2(f) of UGC Act. 1956.

In the college UGC Resource Centre is set up to provide internet access to the students. The college has been accredited **by NAAC** with CGPA of 1.62 **valid up to November 01, 2023**. An Internal Quality Assurance Cell has been set up in the college with a view to bring qualitative improvement in academics. #### GENERAL ADMISSION RULES

#### ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

A candidate will be eligible for admission to the first year if he/she fulfils the eligibility conditions as prescribed by HPU Shimla, which are subject to amendments from time to time.

- 1. A candidate should have passed 10+2 examination conducted by HP Board of School Education or an examination accepted as equivalent thereto by the HP University Shimla.
- 2. For admission in First Year, an applicant must not be more than 23 years of age (25 years for girl students) as on 01-07-2020. The upper age limit for SC/ST candidates is 26 years. However, the Vice Chancellor, HPU Shimla in exceptional circumstances, to be recorded in writing, may allow a relaxation in age up to a period of six months.

#### ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- 1. Initially admission will be provisional. It will be regularised only after verifying all the original certificates and on fulfilment of all eligibility conditions.
- 2. Every candidate seeking admission to any class have to apply on the prescribed form available in the college prospectus.
- 3. The application form is to be filled up neatly by the applicant in his/her own handwriting carefully after reading all the instructions, rules and eligibility conditions.
- 4. The applicant has to bring his/her mother/father/guardian with him/her at the time of admission.
- 5. The applicant must produce original certificates at the time of final admission.
- 6. A candidate having a gap of one or more years in his/her studies will have to submit an undertaking explaining the reasons.
- 7. The girl students seeking admission in any class must produce an attested copy of H.P. Bonafide Certificate to avail concession in tuition fee.
- 8. Physically challenged students seeking admission in their category must attach an attested copy of disability certificate to avail concession in tuition fee.
- 9. Candidates coming from the schools affiliated to education board other than HP Board of School Education must produce migration certificates in original at the time of admission.
- 10. Every student seeking admission in any class will be required to pay a sum of ₹ 300/- per annum towards PTA fund.
- 11. All terms and conditions of the admission and fee structure can be changed or modified as per the directions of H.P.U. Shimla/H.P. Government.
- 12. All admissions will be made on the recommendation of admission committee.
- 13. All admissions will be provisional subject to the approval of Vice Chancellor, HPU Shimla.
- 14. All the fee and funds are to be deposited within the stipulated time.
- 15. The dues once deposited will not be refunded.

**NB:** If a candidate does not deposit fee within the stipulated time period, his/her admission will be deemed as cancelled.

#### REFUSAL FOR ADMISSION

- 1. A candidate expelled by any College/University or found involved in any indisciplinary activity in the preceding year(s) will not be admitted in the college.
- 2. Candidates who have passed OT/MIL and want relaxation in the concerned subject are not eligible for admission in the college.
- 3. The students having compartment in 10+2 class are not eligible for admission.
- 4. Any candidate who has not appeared/passed in English as a subject at 10+2 level shall not be eligible for admission in B.A. 1<sup>st</sup> year.
- 5. If a student gets admission by furnishing incorrect information or by concealing the facts, his /her admission will be cancelled on detection of such fault by the College/ University.
- 6. The Principal reserves the right to reject or cancel the admission of any student without assigning any reason(s) or explanations if situation warrants so.

#### DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION IN FIRST YEAR

The admission form complete in all respects duly attached with bio-data card, undertaking and PTA form must be submitted along with the following documents:-

- 1. Two (2x2.25cm size) photographs of the candidate and one (2x2.25cm size) photograph of his/her father/mother/guardian
- 2. (i) Matriculation Certificate (ii) 10+2 Certificate
  All certificates from matriculation examination onwards must be shown to the admission committee in original along with their photocopies.
- 3. Original Character Certificate issued from Head of the institution last attended (for admission to the 1<sup>st</sup> year). The character certificate must not have been issued more than six months prior
- 4. Photocopy of AADHAAR card
- 5. Photocopy of Voter Card/Electoral Photo Identity Card (EPIC)
- 6. H.P. Domicile Certificate for girl students only
- 7. Photocopy of bank pass book showing account number and IFSC
- 8. Category Certificate in case of a student seeking admission in SC/ST/OBC category
- 9. IRDP/BPL certificate if applicable
- 10. Disability certificate if applicable
- 11. Migration Certificate (in case the student has passed his/ her 10+2 examination from the board other than HPBOSE)
- 12. Affidavit/ undertaking, wherever applicable
- 13. Photocopy of registration card for admission to II and III year

Note: (i) The above documents should be attached with the admission form in the same order.

- (ii) Every student must have his/her own e-mail ID.
  - (iii) Parents must ensure the entry of their Mobile No. in the admission form in order to make it convenient to send them the important messages.

Note: In-case a student has discontinued his/her studies for one or more year(s), the character certificate issued by Head of the Institution last attended must be supplemented by another character certificate obtained from gazetted class-I officer or the Panchayat Pradhan of the area concerned.

#### GENERAL CONDUCT & DISCIPLINE RULES

All the students must note that **ragging inside**/ **outside the college campus is a cognizable offence.** In addition, any of the following activities will be considered a breach of discipline:

- a) Graffiti i.e. any sort of writing on the walls, blackboards, desks etc.
- b) Damaging the college property in any manner.
- c) Loitering around the corridors and causing disturbance to the classes.
- d) Possession or use of drugs and indulgence in smoking.
- e) Bringing outsiders to the college.
- f) Sticking any kind of bills/notice on the notice board without the prior permission of the Principal.
- g) Creating any kind of violence or nuisance in the campus.
- h) Coming without I-Card to the college.
- i) Use of mobile phones in and around the classroom(s) and Exam-Hall(s).

#### Important:-

- i) Stringent action will be taken against the student found guilty of breaching conduct or ules in the college campus.
- ii) Defaulters including students whose names have been struck off the roll(s) will not be allowed to enter the college premises until exonerated or readmitted appropriately.

#### ATTENDANCE

- 1. At least 75% Lecture attendance is compulsory to be eligible for appearing in the final End of Year Exams (EYE) of HPU.
- 2. An irregular student or one who remains absent continuously for 6 days from College/any elective subject, his/her name will be struck-off from the college rolls. If name of a student is struck-off twice, he she shall not be readmitted to the college.
- 3. A student is liable to pay all dues & fines as long as his/her name remains on the college rolls.
- 4. The Principal reserves the right of expulsion/suspension of any student if the situation warrants so.

#### LEAVE RULES

- 1. Application for any kind of leave should be submitted well in time.
- 2. Leave up to three days will be sanctioned by the tutor.
- 3. Leave up to six days will be sanctioned by senior tutor.
- 4. Leave for more than six days will be sanctioned by the Principal on the recommendation of concerned subject teacher/tutor/senior tutor.
- 5. In case of medical leave for a period of more than six days the applicant must produce a medical certificate.



Students participating in inter-college competitions should note that the practice/ rehearsal timing should be either before the classes (early morning) or after the classes (evening).

#### LIBRARY RULES

Every student will be issued an Identity Card. Since I-Card is the only medium to identity/differentiate a bonafide college student from an outsider, every student must always carry it with him/her. Otherwise he/she will be considered an outsider and will be punished accordingly.

- If the I-Card is lost, a duplicate card will be issued only after an FIR is registered with the nearest police station and an original copy thereof is appended with such a request.
- For duplicate Identity Card, ₹ 20/- are to be paid.

#### CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM

The Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) adopted under Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA), provides an opportunity for the students to study courses (from the prescribed courses) according to their choice. Under this system the courses are measured in terms of credits. Credit is a method to measure the volume of content, learning effort, achievement of learning and weightage of the course. The term credit refers to the weightage given to a course usually in terms of assigned instructional hours per week. For purpose of credit determination, one lecture or tutorial of one hour a week & practical of two hours a week is considered as two credits. The colleges affiliated to Himachal Pradesh University have adopted the new annual CBCS since the academic year 2018-19. In the present system a student is required to attain 132 credits during the three year degree course.

#### OUTLINE OF CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM

Four types of courses are required to be studied by a student during his/her 3 year degree course.

- 1. Core Course: A course, which should be compulsorily studied by a candidate as a core requirement is termed as a core course. In this category 4 discipline specific courses two each for DSC1 & DSC2 and four courses of languages (2 of English & 2 of Hindi) are to be studied up to 2<sup>nd</sup> year of 3 year degree course.
- 2. Elective Course: A course which can be chosen from a pool of courses and which may be very specific or specialized or supportive to the discipline/ subject of study or which enables an exposure to some other discipline/ subject is called an Elective Course.
  - **2.1 Discipline** Specific Elective (DSE) Course: Elective courses offered under the main discipline/subject of study are referred to as Discipline Specific Elective courses. In this category, 2 each for DSE1 & DSE2 are to be studied by a student.
  - **2.2 Dissertation/ Project**: Introducing research component in under-graduate courses, dissertation/ project work is considered as a special course involving application of knowledge in solving/ analyzing/ exploring a real life situation/ difficult problem. A Project/ Dissertation work may be given in lieu of a discipline specific elective course of 6 credits.
  - **2.3 Generic Elective Course (GEC):** An elective course chosen from an unrelated discipline/ subject, with an intention to seek exposure beyond disciplines of choice is called a Generic Elective. In this category one each for regular courses are to be studied in 3<sup>rd</sup> year of the degree course.
    - **Note:-** A core course offered in a discipline/ subject may be treated as an elective by other discipline/ subject and vice-versa and such electives may also be referred to as Generic Elective.
- **3. Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course** (AECC): The Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses are mandatory for all disciplines. These courses are based upon the content that leads to Knowledge enhancement. They include (i) Environment Science and (ii) English/ Hindi/ Sanskrit.
- **4. Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC):** The Skill Enhancement Courses aim at providing hands-on-training, competencies, skills etc. and are value & skill-based. These courses may be chosen from a pool of courses designed to provide value-based and /or skill-based knowledge and contain theory and lab/hands-on-training /fixed fieldwork.

- (ii) No fee and funds will be charged from the students with special needs having more than 40% disability (As per DHE Letter No. EDN-H(8)B(15)-HPU-15/2013 Dt. 1/2/2020).
- (iii) HPU Development Fund @ ₹ 100/- will be charged from the students belonging to IRDP/BPL families on the production of valid documents.
- (iv) In addition to the above fee and funds, practical fee @₹ 180/- from the students of Geography and @₹ 360/- from the students of music (V) will also be charged.
- (v) An additional amount of ₹ 400/- will be charged from those first year students who have passed their 10+2 examination from other than HPBOSE Dharamshala.
- (vi) The above-mentioned fee and funds are subject to change as per HPU/HP Government instructions.

#### ZERO TOLERANCE TO RAGGING

Ragging is a punishable offence. Ragging means any act, conduct or practice by which dominant power of senior students is brought to bear on the freshly enrolled or in any way considered junior by other students which involves physical or psychological assault or threat to other students or use of force of violation of dignity and honour of such student or expose students to ridicule and affect their self esteem or entail verbal abuse, aggression, indecent gesture and obscene behaviour. Any student found involved in ragging will be punished strictly and such penalisation may include:

- 1. Expulsion from the college;
- 2. Suspension from the classes;
- 3. Fine with a public apology;
- 4. Withholding scholarships and other benefits;
- 5. Debarring from representation in events;
- 6. Suspension or expulsion from hostel or mess;
- 7. Legal proceedings under criminal law shall be initiated. It includes imprisonment for a term which may extend up to 3 years or with fine which may extend to ₹ 50,000/- or both.
